

How to retrofit a suitable fuse

The problem - all B3/B4 models (with headlight washers)




- The headlight washer pump (V11) is <u>not</u> fused
- See how current track 166 runs direct to permanent 12V
- In the event of a short circuit on this track, there will be damage to the main fusebox

 and potentially a serious electrical fire as a result.
- Two courses of action
 - Remove relay #4 to disable the headlight washer circuitry or
 - Fit a suitable fuse as follows...




Retrofitting a fuse - Preparation





Simplest fuse retrofit – Step by step



- A Terminal T1i is easiest to access in driver's footwell. No need to interfere with fusebox.T1i is a white plug.
- B Disconnect two halves of the white T1i connector.
- C Wire up an in-line fuse holder with a 10A fuse as shown between two halves of the T1i connector plug.
